**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (COLLEGE ROAD, MELTON LANE AND
STATION ROAD, SUTTON BONINGTON AND STATION ROAD, KINGSTON ON SOAR)**
(RESTRICTED ROAD AND 30MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2018 (8275)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Sutton Bonington and Kingston on Soar in the Borough of Rushcliffe:-

1. The following lengths of road shall be restricted roads (30mph) for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act:-

College Road, Sutton Bonington – from the centre line of its junction with Melton Lane in a southerly direction for 22 metres

Melton Lane, Sutton Bonington – from its junction with College Road in a south-easterly direction for 91 metres

Station Road, Sutton Bonington – from its junction with College Road in a westerly then north-westerly direction to the western boundary of The Lodge.

2. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the following lengths of road:-

Melton Lane, Sutton Bonington – from a point 91 metres south-east of its junction with Station Road in an south-easterly direction for 74 metres

Station Road, Kingston on Soar – from the centre line of its junction with Melton Lane in a northerly direction for 86 metres

3. The following Order is hereby revoked in so far as it relates to the lengths of road specified in the Schedules to this Order:-

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Station Road, College Road and Melton Lane, Sutton Bonington and Kingston on Soar) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2014 (8224)

4. Any previous speed limit order made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or any enactment replace by that Act in so far as it related to the lengths of road specified in the Schedules to this Order are hereby revoked.
